THE FLORAL ARRANGEMENT in the Sanctuary today is a love offering to God from Andy & Adela Valdez in thankfulness for Andy's birthday.

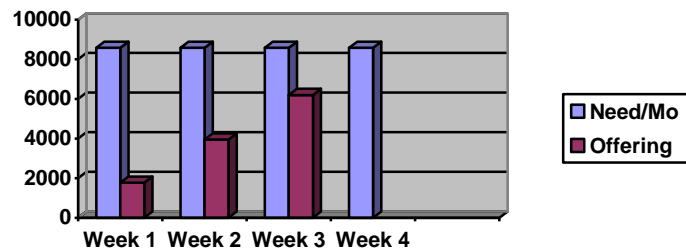

Church Budget June, 2011

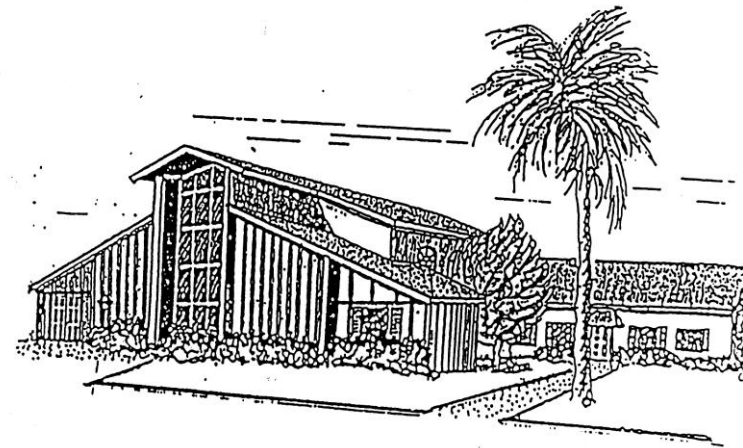
