DEACONESS' MEETING Today, immediately following the Worship Service. Please meet in the Alcove (by the organ). All are urged to attend.

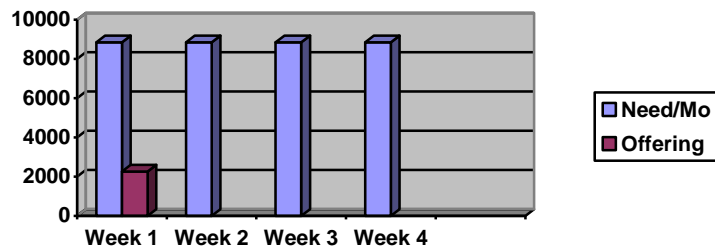

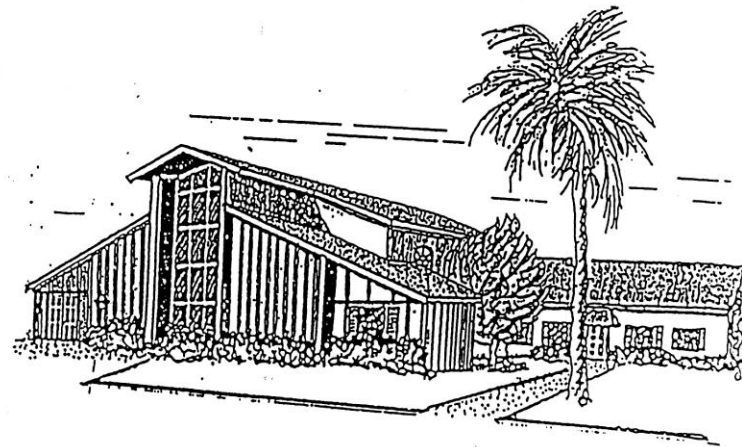
